

## CODE OF CONDUCT

### PDUAM(A) STUDENTS' UNION ELECTION 2025-2026

1. No candidate or student organisations are permitted to stick posters or write any propaganda on the campus. Sticking a poster or writing any propaganda for advertising will be treated as a violation of the election code of conduct.
2. No person who is not a student on the rolls of the college shall be permitted to take part in the election process in any capacity. Any person, candidate, or member of the student's organisation violating the rule shall be subject to disciplinary proceedings, in addition to the candidature, as the case may be, being revoked.
3. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity that may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
4. Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programs, record and work. Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with the public activities of the other candidates or supporters of such other candidates. Criticism of other candidates, or their supporters, based on unverified allegations or distortions shall be avoided.
5. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. Places of worship, within or outside the campus, shall not be used for election propaganda.
6. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging in or abetting any activities considered to be "corrupt practices" and offences, such as bribing voters, intimidating voters, impersonating voters, canvassing, or using propaganda within 100 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings during the 24 hours preceding the close of the poll, and transporting voters to and from polling stations.
7. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlets, or any other printed material for canvassing. Candidates may use only handmade posters for canvassing.
8. No candidate shall be permitted to carry out processions, public meetings, or in any way canvass or distribute propaganda outside the college campus.
9. No candidate shall, nor shall their supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the college campus, for any purpose whatsoever, without the prior written permission of the college authorities. All candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any college property.
10. During the election period, the candidates may hold processions and/or public meetings, provided that such processions and/or public meetings do not, in any manner, disturb the classes

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and other academic and co-curricular activities of the college. Further, such a procession /public meeting may not be held without the prior written permission of the college authority.

11. The use of loudspeakers, vehicles and animals for canvassing shall be prohibited.
12. On the day of polling, student organisations and candidates shall co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subjected to any annoyance or obstruction.
13. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid pass/letter of authority from the election commission or from the college authorities shall enter the polling booths.
14. All the students of the College must come with a proper College Uniform along with a valid ID Card to cast a vote in the election.
15. Any contravention of any of the above recommendations may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his candidature or his elected post, as the case may be. The election commission /college authorities may also take appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator.
16. In addition to the above-mentioned code of conduct, it is also recommended that specific provisions of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 153A and Chapter IXA - "Offences Relating to Election"), may also be made applicable to student elections.



**Students' Union Election Notice 2025-2026**

**Eligibility Criteria for Candidates:-**

1. All bona fide students have the right to take part in the process of the PDUAM (A) SU election. Students admitted to any of the regular and provincialized courses strictly under Gauhati University at PDUAM, Amjonga are bona fide students of this institution.
2. HS students and Degree Final year students are not eligible to contest the SU election.
3. Undergraduate students between the ages of 17 and 22 years may contest in the PDUAM (A) SU election.
4. Students whose average class attendance is less than 75% shall not be eligible to contest in the PDUAM (A) SU election.
5. A candidate shall get one opportunity to contest for a post of Office Bearer.
6. A contesting candidate can propose or support another candidate.
7. A candidate can voluntarily withdraw their candidature. The opinion of his/her proposer or supporter shall have no say over the candidate's decision
8. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say/they should not have been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanour. Candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the College authority.

**Guidelines for Candidates**

The guidelines below apply to candidates contesting elections. Any violation of the guidelines below will result in the Election Officer cancelling the candidature.

1. No classes will be disturbed for campaigning.
2. No Campaigning in the college premises after 1:00 pm, 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.
3. Pasting posters and writing campaigning slogans on walls is prohibited.
4. Candidates shall refrain from personal comments against other candidates.
5. Candidates at the time of speech should refrain from using any defamatory language against any individuals.

In case an equal no of votes are cast in favour of candidates contesting for a post, the head of the present student council, namely the president, shall be allowed "A Casting Vote" to elect a candidate.
